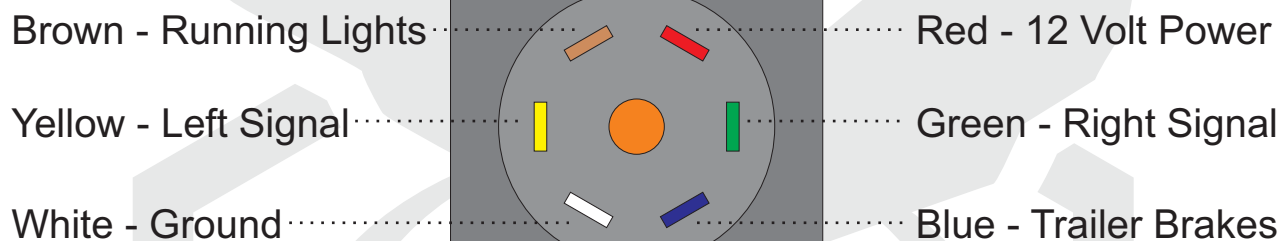
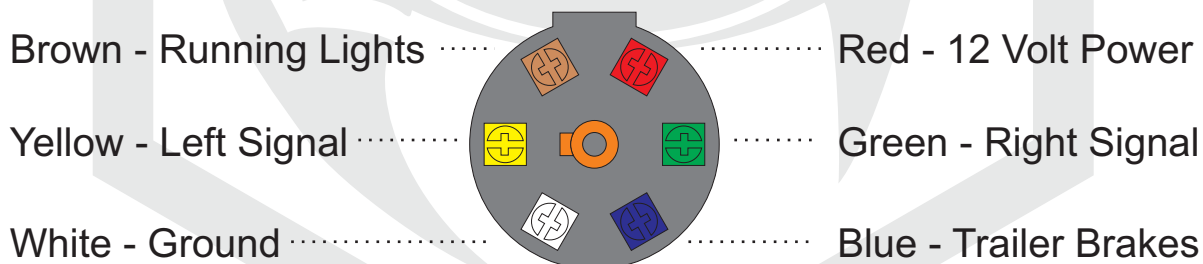




## Truck Plug As Seen With The Lid Up

## Special Notes

\*Note the orange wire is not used. The center prong is an auxiliary power commonly used as a back up light. It will commonly be found as orange or purple.

\*Modern pickup trucks from 1997-1999 and newer have a dual circuit fuse system. This means that your vehicle lights may function properly and your trailer lights may not (or vice versa).

\*Some GM trucks from 1999-2007 require a fuse to be installed in order for the trailer charging system to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.

\*Some GM trucks from 2008+ require two wires to be connected for the charging system and trailer brakes to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.

\*Some Ford F150's require a relay to be installed in order for the charging system to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.
