


Truck Plug As Seen With The Lid Up

Brown - Running Lights	Red - 12 Volt Power
Yellow - Left Signal ·······	Green - Right Signal
White - Ground ·····	Blue - Trailer Brakes

Special Notes

- *Note the orange wire is not used. The center prong is an auxiliary power commonly used as a back up light. It will commonly be found as orange or purple.
- *Modern pickup trucks from 1997-1999 and newer have a dual circuit fuse system. This means that your vehicle lights may function properly and your trailer lights may not (or vise versa).
- *Some GM trucks from 1999-2007 require a fuse to be installed in order for the trailer charging system to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.
- *Some GM trucks from 2008+ require two wires to be connected for the charging system and trailer brakes to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.
- *Some Ford F150's require a relay to be installed in order for the charging system to function. Check your vehicle owner's manual.
